Guidelines for Application

The application process is divided into three steps. Applications must be received in SCABB Central Office no later than 90 days prior to the AIMS for the current scholarship year.

Step 1: Applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Applicant must either be an individual member, employed by an institutional member, or currently enrolled in a higher education institution with a focus on immunohematology and reference laboratory work.
2. Applicant must reside, have a residence, or be employed by a hospital or blood center in the United States.
3. Applicant must be engaged, either through employment or education, in the field of immunohematology or reference laboratory.

Step 3: Provide Supporting Documentation:

1. Submit a written request for scholarship including explanation of need. This separate document should be one or two paragraphs stating personal/professional career path in the field of immunohematology or the reference laboratory as well as desire to attend the Advanced Immunohematology and Molecular Symposium presented by South Central Association of Blood Banks.
2. Submit a brief statement from employer or learning institution supporting applicant attendance at the AIMS.

Fax or email all application documentation to the South Central Association of Blood Banks Central Office by no later than 90 days prior to the AIMS offering of the current scholarship year. Applications will be promptly reviewed.
